

Regent House membership for retired/retiring University staff

Special Ordinance A (i) includes the following:

The Registry shall inscribe on the Roll of the Regent House the names of the following persons:

- (e) any person who applies for membership of the Regent House and meets the following criteria: applicants must have retired or be about to retire from an office or appointment in the University which previously qualified them for membership of the Regent House and have provided to the Registry by 15 August prior to the promulgation of the Roll each year written confirmation from their Head of institution¹ that they are active participants in the University's affairs;

¹ 'Head of institution' means the Head of a Department, Chair of a Board of a Faculty not organised into Departments, Director or the authorised deputy or designated nominee, as appropriate within that institution.

The form must be returned by **no later than 15 August** in order for the applicant's name to be included on the Roll of the Regent House published in November of the same year.

A new form must be completed each year, otherwise the applicant's name will be removed from the Roll.
